# I. Minutes of the GIMS 2008 Business Meeting, March 11, New Orleans

- Discussed obtaining a unit handbook from APS (i.e., "How-To" Manual) and fine tuning it to apply to GIMS.
- Suggested to have afternoon session immediately before the business meeting in order to increase attendance.
- Discussion on spending money ways to increase spending, since balance has been accumulating.
  - Travel grants to reimburse travel expenses, specifically for foreign attendees. However, it may be necessary to set a limit
  - Advertise that there is a limited amount of money to help defray cost for invited speakers who can't afford to attend. This caveat is suggested to be included in letters of invitation.
  - Authority to disburse to be through the session chair. These funds are to distribute at his/her discretion up to a maximum approved by the secretarytreasurer.
- Moved and accepted to allocate 10% of the Treasury balance for a travel budget, to be administered by program chair at their discretion.
- Fellowship chair and vice chair to nominate fellows.

- Chair should should have timeline for all respective duties.
- Current officers need to read unit handbook and program chair handbook.
- Election results due earlier: April for Fellowship nomination deadline. September is deadline for decisions.
- ► Chair to appoint Committee of 3 (Al Macrander, Jim Matey, Carolyn MacDonald) to put together list of dos and don'ts from previous chairs (including unwritten rules). To be edited by the sec.-treas. (Al Macrander).
- Suggestions from the floor about changes in arrangements for the GIMS March meeting dinner to increase attendance:
  - 1. Have reception after Keithley meeting, and before business meeting.
  - Serve wine and cheese at business meeting, and still have dinner afterwards.
  - 3. Have no time gap between session and business meeting.
  - 4. Offer sign up for one year free membership at focus session.
